Dear Parents/ Carers,

We will be holding a **Rights Respecting Week** next week beginning on **Monday 12th November**. There will be a **coffee afternoon for parents on Monday 12th November from 2:45pm to 3:15pm upstairs in Block C** where parents can meet our Rights Respecting Schools Coordinator, Oliver Larkin, to discuss the Rights Respecting School Award and how you can support your child at home.

This will be an exciting time in school with lots going on from Nursery to Year 6, looking at rights across the curriculum.

Nursery/Reception - Literacy	We will be looking at the Rights we can find in Nursery Rhymes.
Year 1 - Art	We will be creating artistic pieces to portray our Golden Rights.
Year 2 - Computing	We will be learning all about how to stay safe online during some fun workshops with our teachers.
Years 3 and 4 - RE	We will have a visit from other children from Grafton Primary School who will be telling us all about their religions and we will visit different places of worship.
Year 5 - Science	We will be exploring air pollution in our local community and writing letters to Michael Gove the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs.
Year 6 - History	We will be looking at child labour during the Victorian period and comparing it to the experiences of children currently, writing to UN Secretary-General , António Guterres, to take action against child labour in the world today.

As a thank you for our fantastic advocacy on air pollution, Unicef have given tickets for some lucky children to attend the Nitto ATP Finals at the O2 Arena on Thursday 15th November.

It is also **Anti-Bullying Week** that week and we will be celebrating **Children In Need** on **Friday 16th November**. We are asking for children to **dress up in spots or stripes and make a suggested donation of £1** that day to donate to Children in Need.
