Bonner Primary School has started to use the online maths learning program 'Mathletics'. Your child will have access to Mathletics at both home and school through a unique username and password which they have been given in class. Mathletics contains lots of maths content organised into learning blocks which children can complete through games, challenges, quizzes or activities. In the Summer Term, children will be set weekly homework via Mathletics to complete at home. This will be linked to their maths learning for that week and teachers will be able to monitor their class's progress.
